Sabrina passed around sign ups sheets for concession duty and game day meals. Sabrina talked about cooking brisket for the home run derby and selling plates of food for \$6. Jeff Staton volunteered to cook the brisket. Maggie introduced the other members who are involved with our games. Vince Cortez is our announcer, John Fiekis is in charge of the music, Kathy Staton will be decorating the girls' lockers and the bulletin board, Julie Mayfield will be decorating the home stands, Dan Poole is our statistician and Matt Groff, who is the junior principal will be in charge of the dugout dawgs. There are 21 dawgs this season. Mark Wallace spoke about membership and stressed that we are striving for 100% membership this year.
